I welcome the stated policy objective of designating urban focused local electoral areas around the larger towns. As a member of Kerry County Council and a former member of Killarney Town Council, I am very aware of the lack of urban focus since the abolition of the town councils.

While I remain strongly in favour of the restoration of town councils, I realise that the committee's remit does not allow for this consideration.

In Kerry, both Tralee and Killarney meet the criteria set out in point number 4 of the terms of reference.


I therefore submit that Local Electoral Areas in Kerry should be redefined and both Tralee and Killarney should have local electoral areas which reflect the towns and their hinterlands as closely as possible.

I believe that this is possible without major disruption to the municipal district structure.
