Recently 2 options for the new LEA were put before us at council.**

**Option (1) shows 5 wards,**

**City North West**

**City North East**

**City South West**

**City South East and**

**City South Central.**

**Option (2) contains all the above with the inclusion of a 6<sup>th</sup> ward, City Centre.**

**The inclusion of this ward cuts my ward City South Central into 2 splitting my vote and forcing me to make a decision that will leave many of my voters in limbo including me.**

**I ask that you would give consideration to option (1) when you make your decision in due course. I feel and know that option (1) will allow me to continue my work at grassroots level throughout my ward and I will willingly accept the extra representative workload from the extended boundary, this is a challenge that I would welcome, I know that many of my colleagues feel the same although they may not take the time to put forward a submission.**

**Option (2) 6 wards will not serve the city centre any better than it is served at the moment. This bond should be maintained to ensure continued trusted representation.**
