

Courtmacsherry, a tourist village along the West Cork coastline is located 16 kilometres from Clonakilty and 20 kilometres from Bandon and 31 kilometres from Kinsale. The village along with it's sister villages of Lislevane and Butlerstown are part of the greater hinterland of Barryroe that is best described as real West Cork.
